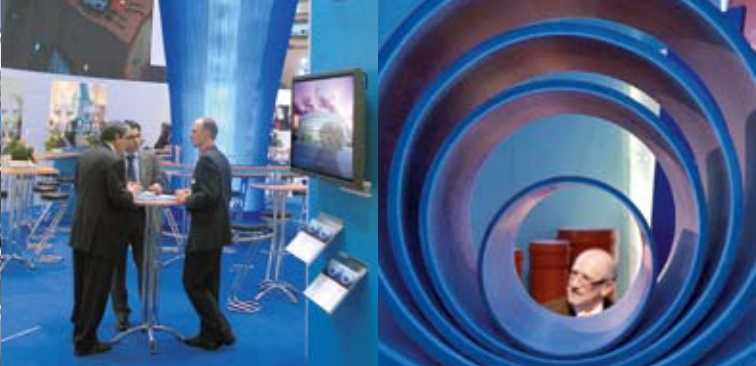

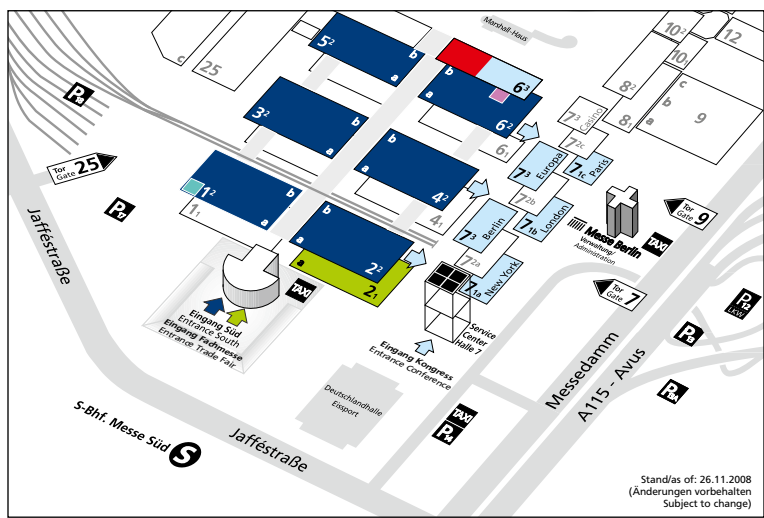

INTERNATIONALITY OF THE TRADE VISITORS



With 20 percent, the share of international trade visitors at WASSER BERLIN was significantly higher in 2006 than in 2003.
