**International Alumni Summer School “Urban Water Supply and Sewage Treatment – New Applications and Technologies“ (27th April – 9th May 2008)**

Subsequent to the summer school „Clean Drinking Water - A Millennium Goal“ in 2007, TU Berlin is organizing another alumni Summer School in 2008.

We are pleased to call for papers for the international alumni summer school on

**“Urban Water Supply and Sewage Treatment – New Applications and Technologies“  
(27th April – 9th May 2008)**

The summer school will be conducted in co-operation and with support of the DAAD und will consist of a seminar with excursion in Berlin and a visit to the IFAT fair in Munich including meetings with exhibitors and with alumni from other German universities.

**Part 1: Summer School at TU Berlin (27th April – 3rd May 2008)**

The IFAT visit (for further information on IFAT please see: <http://www.ifat.de>) and the programme in Munich will be organized by DAAD in co-operation with the German Agency for Water, Wastewater and Recycling (DWA). A special programme will be organized by DAAD including meetings with exhibitors, “multipliers” in the water sector and alumni from University of Karlsruhe, University of Siegen and other German universities. The IFAT offers several forums on water, wastewater and waste management in English language. A special forum for Alumni will be organized by DAAD also in English.

The paper should focus on a water, wastewater or waste management issue or deal with co-operation or management issues in the water and waste management sector. The paper should not exceed two pages. However, instead of a paper a longer PowerPoint presentation will also be accepted. Participants are expected to deliver a short presentation during the summer school (20 minutes).
- Forward a short c.v. giving information on personal data, studies at home and in Germany, professional development and present position and duties including a portrait photo in digital or printed form. Please include your declaration of consent, that we forward your personal data to internationally operating German enterprises.

The selection of the participants will be based on the papers and their professional focus.

We would be pleased to receive papers by alumni from universities, industry, government

and public sectors and NGOs.
