

# IPSWaT – International Postgraduate Studies in Water Technologies

The scholarship programme aims to support outstandingly qualified young scientists in attending German universities to acquire Master's degrees or PhDs that are international in outlook, related to water technologies, and taught in English.

Up to now:

- 20 accredited universities in Germany
- 300 scholarship holders and alumni (Master and PhD)
- from 55 countries worldwide



## Aims of the programme:

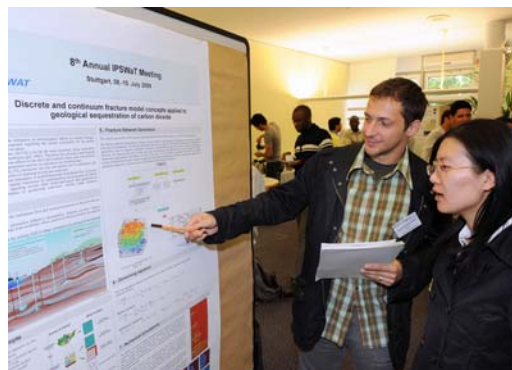


1. Promoting **capacity building and networking** for taking on international responsibility and meeting global challenges.
2. Strengthening **water research cooperation** worldwide
3. Strengthening the international cooperation of the German **water technology** sector
4. Strengthening long-term cooperation with **developing countries**

## Career:

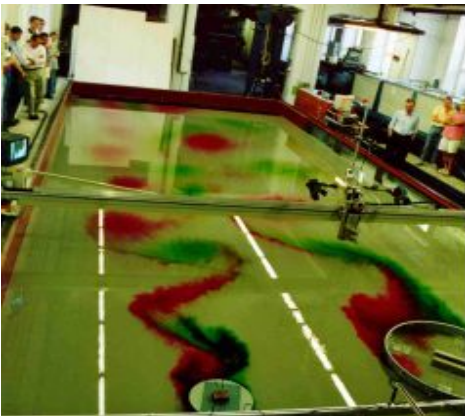
Scholarship holders, besides a comprehensive mentoring,

- all IPSWaT- scholarship holders within annual meetings.

- **German Development Agencies include IPSWaT experts into their projects in developing countries**
- **Brazilian IPSWaT experts will be included into the Água-DF / IWAS project in Brasília**
- **Usbekistan IPSWaT experts are cooperating with multi stakeholder workshop in Usbekistan on Water Efficiency, september 2009**
- **Vietnamese IPSWaT alumni will be important stakeholder in the future for the German cooperation with Vietnam (MoNRE, Universities)**



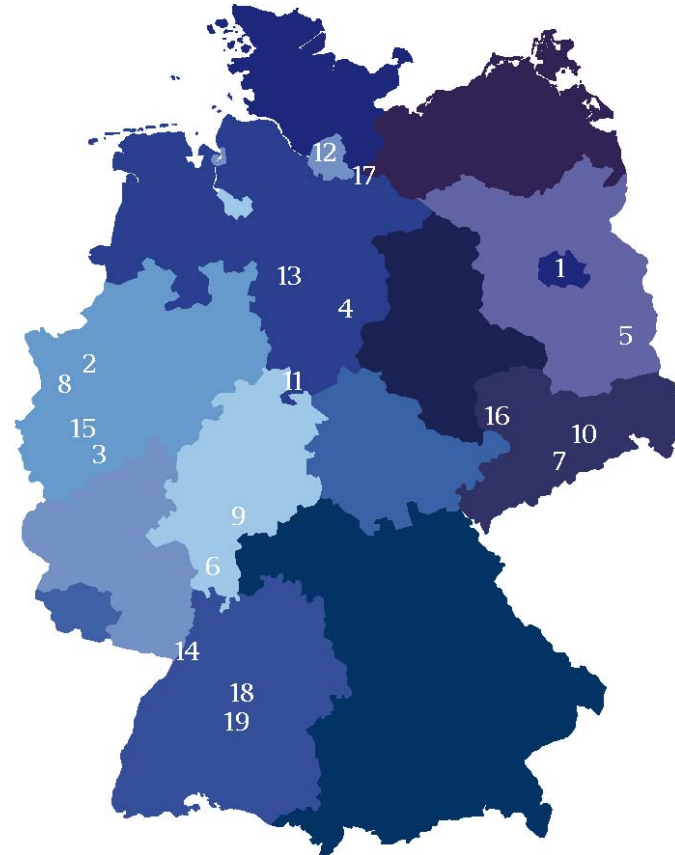
## Application:

1. Applicants must apply to the course director of the Master's programme of one of the accredited universities or to the PhD supervisor;
2. The course director or supervisor recommends the applicant to the International Bureau of the Federal Ministry of Education and Research;
3. Applications will be assessed by an independent panel of experts twice a year.
